
1. Pursuant to the order dated 31.05.2022 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the portal for acceptance of applications by new institutions was opened by the PCI. The circulars informing prospective applicants in this regard have been issued from time to time. The reference may be made to circulars dated 21.6.2022, 03.07.2022, 04.08.2022, 30.08.2022 and 19.9.2022 which are available on the PCI website.

2. The applicants which had submitted applications previously in terms of interim orders passed by the Hon'ble High Court in 2019 were also required to submit the application along with necessary documents and pay the prescribed Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges (PERC) in order to be considered for approval for the academic year 2022-23.
3. All such applicants are given one more opportunity to submit all the relevant documents and pay the requisite fees on the PCI portal in order to be considered for approval for the academic year 2022-23. The portal for such categories of applicants is being opened from 13.10.2022 to 21.10.2022.
4. Applicants may refer to the notices dated 21.06.2022, 03.07.2022, 04.08.2022, 30.08.2022 and 19.9.2022 along with the Schemes issued for the various courses which are available on the PCI website. Such applicants must take a note that they are required to submit the following documents on the portal along with their SIF for the course for which the applicants are desirous of being considered for approval along with PERC for academic year 2022-23 -
  - i) **For D.Pharm course**
    - Consent of affiliation of the Examining Authority for 2022-2023 academic session.
  - ii) **For B.Pharm course**
    - Consent of affiliation of the Examining Authority for 2022-2023 academic session.
    - NOC of the State Government. The NOC of the State Government for previous years shall be treated as applicable for 2022-2023 academic session also.
  - iii) **For M.Pharm course established by the Central Government / State Governments.**

    - Consent of affiliation of the Examining Authority for 2022-2023 academic session.
5. Applicant must ensure that fees in accordance with the prescribed PERC charges are paid in order to be considered for approval for the academic year 2022-23.
6. Please note that this is the last and final opportunity being provided. Please ensure that all the relevant details and documents are furnished well before the closing of the portal.
