Sub: Opening of PCI Portal for new Institutions in pursuance of judgment dt. 31.5.2022 passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court.

Sir/Madam

- A. In pursuance of judgment dt. 31.5.2022 passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court, the portal for new institutions will be opened by the PCI in due course of time. The dates will be announced shortly. Hence keep visiting the PCI website.
- B. In this connection, I am directed to state that -
- a) At present, the following Regulations are in vogue -
 - a) The Education Regulations, 2020 for Diploma Course in Pharmacy.
 - b) The Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014.
 - c) The Master of Pharmacy (M.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014.
 - d) Pharm.D. Regulations, 2008.
 - e) Bachelor of Pharmacy (Practice) Regulations, 2014.
 - f) Minimum Qualification for Teachers in Pharmacy Institutions Regulations, 2014.
 - g) Pharmacy Practice Regulations, 2015.

These Regulations are available on Council's website www.pci.nic.in

- b) For the purpose of consideration of approval of D.Pharm and B.Pharm course, the PCI has framed the "Schemes" which are available on Council's website under the tab "Procedure/Forms". As per the said schemes, the following statutory documents are prerequisite and mandatory for -

a) **For B.Pharm course**

- i) Consent of affiliation of Examining Authority for 2022-2023 academic session.
- ii) NOC of the State Government for 2022-2023 academic session.

In case, the State Government has done away with the issuance of NOC of the State Government for starting of pharmacy course, in that case institution shall upload the said communication from the State Government as a documentary evidence.


b) For D.Pharm

- Consent of affiliation of the Examining Authority for 2022-2023 academic session.

C. Please note that the above documents shall be in English duly signed by the Principal and legible. Further these documents shall clearly reflect that these are for academic session 2022-2023.

In view of above, all pharmacy institutions are requested to make sure that they are able to obtain the above cited statutory documents and submit the same along with the online SIF.
