**Opening of Portal for new Institutions**

To all

1. New Pharmacy Institutions
2. The Examining Authorities (Universities/Boards)
3. The State Governments

Sub: Opening of Portal for new Institutions.

Ref: PCI circular No.14-56/2022 (Approval Process for 2022-2023 as)/ 11621-23 dt.21.6.2022.

Sir/Madam

1. In pursuance of judgment dt.31.5.2022 passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court, the PCI portal has been opened from 3.7.2022 to 15.7.2022 for new institutions. It is clarified that mere submission of application does not mean approval and further action would be subject to outcome of Hon'ble Supreme Court judgement.
2. The institution will have to apply on the PCI portal along with pre-requisite statutory documents. The details of said statutory documents, qualifying criteria, procedure for applying, Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges etc. are specified in the following **Schemes** as available on Council's website www.pci.nic.in under the tab 'Procedure/Forms'
  - a) Scheme for approval of D.Pharm course u/s 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 and the Education Regulations, 2020 for Diploma course in Pharmacy.
  - b) Scheme framed under regulation 9 of the Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014.
  - c) Scheme framed under regulation 4.1 b) of the Master of Pharmacy (M.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014.

Further it may be noted that as per regulation 4.2 a) of "The Master of Pharmacy (M.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014" –

- i) only those institutions which are established by the Central Government/State Government for the purpose of imparting postgraduate education shall be eligible for starting M.Pharm course directly.
- ii) Institutions which are not approved for running B.Pharm course u/s 12 of the Pharmacy Act are not eligible to apply for M.Pharm course.
- iii) specializations / subjects in which M.Pharm degree can be awarded are specified in Appendix-A of "The Master of Pharmacy (M.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014".

**3. Please note that -**


- a) the pre-requisite statutory documents i.e. consent of affiliation of Examining Authority, NOC of the State Government etc. shall clearly indicate that it is for 2022-2023 academic session. The submission of these pre-requisite statutory documents is a mandatory requirement.
- b) these documents shall be in English language duly signed by the Principal and legible.
- c) submission of these statutory documents is a pre-requisite mandatory requirement to become eligible to apply in application proforma titled 'SIF'.
- d) institution shall also ensure strict compliance of following statutory Regulations –
  - i) The Education Regulations, 2020 for Diploma Course in Pharmacy
  - ii) The Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014.
  - iii) The Master of Pharmacy (M.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014.
  - iv) Minimum Qualification for Teachers in Pharmacy Institutions Regulations, 2014.
- e) number of admissions are restricted as per following details -

<u>Course</u>	<u>No. of admissions permitted</u>
D.Pharm -	60
B.Pharm -	60 / 100
M.Pharm -	15 per specialization

- f) Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges - The institution is required to pay the registration fee, other PERC and service fee as Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges. For the payment of the said charges multiple payment gateways are available and include payments through BillDesk, SBI through NEFT / RTGS. Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges are non refundable.

- g) Institutions have to apply necessarily online only on PCI portal within the prescribed date along with prescribed statutory documents and Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges. No hard copy of the documents / Demand Draft etc. will be entertained and same will be filed. The PCI will not be responsible for the consequences and hence due caution be exercised in the matter.
- h) The last date for applying will not be extended under any circumstances and hence institutions are required to apply without fail within the available window.
