Sub: Issue regarding students admitted above 60 in D.Pharm Course.

Sir/Madam

With reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to inform that subject cited issue was considered by Executive Committee in its meeting held in Aug, 2014 which noted that -

PCI does not permit admissions above 60 in D.Pharm course.

some diploma pharmacy institutions admit students above 60 in violation of the Council's b)

examination of excess students are conduced by the Examining Authority. This results in c) litigations.

In view of above, it was decided to write to all Examining Authorities clarifying that PCI does not grant approval above 60 admissions in D.Pharm course and hence the Examining Authority shall not conduct the examination in respect of students admitted over and above the sanctioned intake by PCI failing which PCI may consider withdrawal of approval of examination granted u/s 12(2) of the Pharmacy Act for the purpose of qualifying for registration as a pharmacist. For consequences, if any, like litigation etc. the Examination Authority shall be responsible.
