

FOR ATTENTION OF INSTITUTIONS RUNNING B. PHARM COURSE APPROVED BY THE PHARMACY COUNCIL OF INDIA FOR THE PURPOSE OF REGISTRATION AS A PHARMACIST UNDER THE PHARMACY ACT, 1948.

Introduction of 5 ½ year integrated course leading to award of 4 years Bachelor degree (Engineering/Pharmacy/HMCT) and Master of Management (in the respective discipline) after 5 ½ years which includes six months internship- public notice by AICTE.

Clarification regarding registration of pharmacists under The Pharmacy Act, 1948.

It is brought to the notice of the pharmacy institutions that only following qualifications acquired from an institution approved u/s 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 are approved by the Pharmacy Council of India for the purpose of registration as a pharmacist to practice the profession under the Pharmacy Act.

- D.Pharm	: 2 years & 500 hours practical training course.
- B.Pharm	: 4 years course.
- Pharm.D	: 6 years course.
