**Sub.: Regarding the ethical issues like professional practice etc.**

Sir/Madam

With reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to inform the subject cited issue was considered by 93<sup>rd</sup>/CC in its meeting held in July,13 which is noted that-


- a) the minimum qualification for registration as a pharmacist is Diploma in Pharmacy.
- b) there is a provision u/s 35 of the Pharmacy Act for entry of additional qualifications

It was decided to write to all Pharmacy institutions to ensure that-

- a) pharmacy teaching faculty is currently registered with the State Pharmacy Council.
- b) registration No. of the teacher is uploaded on the Council's website.
- c) teaching faculty has entered his additional pharmacy qualification u/s 35 of the Pharmacy Act with the State Pharmacy Council.
- d) pharmacy institutions running pharmacy courses approved by the PCI shall submit the details of other pharmacy courses run by them in the same building.
- e) the Principal to submit the duly attested affidavit that he has not violated any regulation of the PCI.

This is for strict Compliance & necessary action.
