Sub: Duty leave to PCI inspectors.

## Sir/Madam

- 1. This has a reference to the subject cited above. In this connection, it is informed that
  - a) PCI has made panel of PCI inspectors u/s 16 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 consisting of pharmacy faculty from various pharmacy institutions across the country.
  - b) these inspectors are deputed by the PCI to inspect any institution and attend any approved pharmacy examination.
- 2. It has been noted that in some cases, inspectors decline inspection as they are either not permitted by the Management / Principal or they are short of leaves due to which their salary is deducted thus causing them financial loss. In some cases they are not allowed to inspect as inspection of their own institution is planned during those dates.
- 3. Since approval process is a time bound activity and conduct of inspection is statutory in nature, it is requested that
  - a) time spent by the inspectors for inspection work be treated as a duty leave as a special case.
  - b) in case inspection of your own institution is coinciding with the dates given to your faculty as PCI inspectors for inspection of other institution(s), you may keep some documentary evidences like a copy of Adhar Card, copy of PCI's deputation letter etc. for showing to the inspecting team of your institution and allow your faculty to complete the inspection work assigned by the PCI.
- 4. You kind support will go in a long way in completing the approval process.
