Sub: Recognition of foreign university students in pharmacy for teaching in Indian pharmacy institutions.

The Pharmacy Council of India in its 103rd Central Council meeting has decided that the PCI may consider-

- a) equivalence of foreign pharmacy qualifications with pharmacy qualification granted by Indian Universities for the purpose of teaching in pharmacy institutions approved u/s 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948.
- b) such applications / requests shall be forwarded by the institution where applicant intends to join as teaching faculty.
- c) the equivalence shall be considered only for the purpose of teaching in pharmacy institutions approved by the PCI.
- d) the applicant institution shall submit the following documents to the PCI -
 - i) application fee of Rs.25,000/-.
 - ii) detailed course curriculum for both theory and practicals including number of hours devoted to each subject.
 - iii) academic certificates duly endorsed by the Embassy / High Commission of that country in India from where the applicant has acquired the said foreign qualification.
