With reference to the subject cited above, your kind attention is invited to Section 32 of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016. The same is quoted below -

Reservations in Higher Educational Institutions


“32(1) : All Govt. Institutions of higher education and other higher education institutions receiving aid from the Government shall reserve not less than five percent. seats for persons with benchmark disabilities.

32(2) : The persons with benchmark disabilities shall be given an upper age relaxation of five years for admission in institutions of higher education.”

Please note that the above provisions of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 are a binding to all concerned.
