

**Action Taken Report on Anti-ragging**

**(A) Anti-Ragging Committee**

- (i) The University formed an "Anti-ragging Committee" headed by the Proctor of the University. It comprises of Head Administration, selected Faculty members, senior students and selected non teaching staff. **(Annexure-I)**
- (ii) This committee is totally responsible to ensure that no incidence of ragging, as given in the UGC regulations takes place. They would also ensure that the instructions of these regulations are followed fully at all times.
- (iii) The anti-ragging committee along with faculty members also maintained alert vigil at all times and ensure that there is no case of ragging in the University. **(Annexure-II)**

**(B) Anti-Ragging Patrols**

- (i) Regular patrolling was done by committee members consisting of Proctor, Head Administration and Security.
- (ii) Patrols would operate on all days in the campus and also in various hostels for 3 month. (July to September, 2014)

**(C) Posters in the University**

- (i) Posters were displayed at various places in the campus containing information on contact numbers of the Proctor, Head Administration and senior student representative of the anti-ragging committee. **(Annexure-III)**
- (ii) Fresher's were asked not to hesitate or feel shy of reporting any incident of ragging in the University.
- (iii) Fresher's were asked to move in groups and immediately report at any time of the day or night, any attempt or any incident of ragging to the

Proctor, Hostel authority or any of the authority whose contact number are given on the notice boards of the hostel/academic blocks.

- (iv) Fresher's were asked to go through the uploaded information on SPSU website pertaining to anti ragging.
- (v) The important phone numbers of the authority were saved by the fresher's in their mobile phone to immediately report any untoward incident.

(D) Instructions specific to the Hostels

- (i) The newly admitted students were lodged in separate hostels of the University.
- (ii) No one, particularly senior students are permitted to enter the fresher's hostel at any time.
- (iii) The responsibility for ensuring the above instructions was made through the Wardens, Assistant Wardens and security officers.
- (iv) Attendance of the fresher's is taken by the Warden and Assistant Wardens of the hostel, regularly at 9.00pm daily.
- (v) All day scholars were required to leave the campus latest by 5.30pm as soon as their classes were over.

The Anti-ragging committee along with the faculty team and senior students involved with the team ensure from time to time that no incident of ragging takes place in the University, thereby making the University "Ragging Free".



At the outset, Prof. H. Devaraj, Vice-Chairman, UGC welcomed all the members and briefly explained the various Anti Ragging initiatives taken by the UGC. He explained that in pursuance to the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 08.05.2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009, the University Grants Commission has framed "UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions, 2009" notified on 17<sup>th</sup> June, 2009 which are in force.

After a round of introductions the Hon'ble Chairman addressed all the participants to work actively on the issue of ragging. Since ragging is a serious issue and there should be a change of mindset of students and parents. It is therefore imperative on the part of all of us to eradicate this evil completely. Prevention of Ragging should emerge as a social awareness programme in higher educational institutions.

As discussed on Agenda Item No.1, Member Secretary, with the permission of the chair, asked the committee to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. All the members approved the minutes of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Meeting of the Inter Council & Coordination Group held on 21.03.2014.

As discussed on Agenda Item No.2, several regulatory authorities, namely, Dental Council of India, Indian Council of Agricultural Research, Medical Council of India, Bar Council of India, All India Council for Technical Education and Pharmacy Council of India

made verbal presentations & submitted their written reports to the  
Anti-Ragging Bureau. ||

It has been decided in the meeting to request the University/Institutions to strictly follow the Anti Ragging Regulations made by UGC and other regulatory authorities. From time to time, UGC has also issued the Public Notices in the leading newspapers and send the circulars on "curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institutions". A }

The Medical Council of India representative Mr. Anil Kumar, Chairman, Admin & Grievances Cell, made the detailed presentation on the ragging cases pertaining to Medical Council of India (MCI) and also briefed about the suicide case of Ms. Priyanka Mukherjee, who committed suicide due to ragging.

The Member Secretary, UGC asked the CEO, Syrex Info Services Pvt. Ltd. to respond to the complaint received from the employees of Syrex Info Services Pvt. Ltd, New Delhi.

Monitoring Agency (MA) made a power point presentation wherein the agency said that a total of roughly 3000 complaints were received by the Call Centre since June 2009. Last year had recorded the highest number of complaints at 640. The Monitoring Agency (MA) drew the attention of the Committee to an exceptionally high number of complaints received from Medical Colleges across the Country. The Monitoring Agency drew the attention of the committee to the fact that the medical colleges do not respond to the ragging complaints calls. MCI requested the Monitoring Agency (MA) to bring all such cases to the notice of MCI. Representative of

MCI assured that appropriate action will be taken against the erring colleges.

The Chairman of the Committee along with others members of the Committee advised Monitoring Agency (MA) not to use the word notorious against Universities/Vice-Chancellor/Principal of the College. He also requested the Monitoring Agency to act as facilitator instead of criticizing the UGC and other regulatory bodies.

Monitoring Agency (MA) requested to the Chairman to constitute a sub-committee of 5 members for periodical review of the work of the Anti Ragging Cell in depth and submit a report to this committee with recommendations & plan of action.

As discussed on Agenda Item No.3, the Member Secretary requested the chairperson to constitute a small committee comprising of Director INFLIBNET, Ahmedabad, Member of Monitoring Agency and UGC officials to look into the problems/modifications in Standard Operating Procedures (SOP).

The Member Secretary emphasized to use of SOP in other regulatory bodies also.

The Members Secretary read out that total 52 complaints pertained to UGC as of now, out of which in 5 cases show causes notice has been issued to the college authority, 18 new cases have been registered in UGC out of which 9 first reminder has been sent to colleges/universities and 9 second reminder has already been sent to colleges/universities. In 11 cases of ragging, improper report has

been received from college authority and reminder has already been sent to college for sending the proper report to UGC for further necessary action in the cases. 15 cases have been sent for closure to the Monitoring Agency and returned back to UGC, in these cases victim has not been satisfied. 3 cases have been sent to other bureaus of UGC for further follow up action in the cases. Regulatory Bodies are also requested to send the complete and satisfactory Anti Ragging Committee Report to UGC for closing the ragging case.

The Members Secretary, UGC requested the Monitoring Agency (MA) to close the cases in SOP, which were approved for closure by the Chairman, UGC earlier i.e. before the installation of SOP. It was discussed in the meeting that no additional funds will be made available to the Monitoring Agency for installation of SOP in the system of officers and staffs of Anti Ragging Cell.

Monitoring Agency was requested to send the following details to UGC for further review of the Monitoring Agency:-

- 1) How many cases were settled by the Monitoring Agency.
- 2) SOP installation on the computers of staff of officers of Anti Ragging Cell.
- 3) How many compliance has been received by the Monitoring Agency and what action has been taken by the Monitoring Agency on incomplete compliances.
- 4) Action taken by Monitoring Agency on the ragging cases along with the duration of the case before forwarding the case to UGC.

The Member Secretary requested the Members of the Committee to upload the detailed enquiry report of ragging cases on their website.



The Member Secretary with permission of chair, requested all the Councils to get their Institutions NAAC Accredited and send the compliance report to UGC.

As discussed in Agenda item No. 4, the Monitoring Agency may be requested to provide modified Self Declaration Proforma as communicated in the minutes of the meeting sent to Monitoring Agency on 4<sup>th</sup> December, 2014. Modified Self declaration Proforma is not yet provided by the Monitoring Agency.

The Member Secretary discussed the Action Taken Report in detail on the Minutes of the 16<sup>th</sup> Meeting of Dr. R.K. Raghvan, Former Director, CBI.

While concluding the meeting, The Hon'ble Chairman thanked the committee members for their commitment to the cause of eradication of Ragging. He promised the Anti-Ragging Cell full support of UGC and his personal support whenever required.

Hon'ble Chairman proposed vote of thanks to the Committee Members.



- After the implementation of Rules and Regulations of anti-ragging and due to constant vigilance by respective committees, there is good impact on smooth management of students' discipline.
- All the College Deans have been instructed to make it compulsory for each student and every parent to submit an online undertaking every academic year.

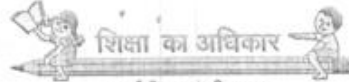
Respected Madam,

I have requested you on phone on 11.11.2014 for organizing Inter Council & Coordination Committee meeting on Anti-Ragging. Last such meeting was held on 21.3.2014 under Chairmanship of Vice Chairman, UGC (copy enclosed - A-I). One of the agenda items could be implementation of action taken on the Minutes of the 16th meeting of Anti-ragging Monitoring Committee held in UGC on 12.6.2014 under the Chairmanship of Dr. R.K. Raghavan, former CBI Director (copy enclosed - A-II). I may mention that in the last meeting Dr A K Agarwal Ex-Dean, Maulana Azad Medical College and Member Monitoring Committee desired that all the Regulatory Bodies/Institutions shall include all related information like complete addresses and contact numbers with mobile nos., emergency call numbers, E-Mails and Fax of the institutional heads, Dean/Prof./Proctor/Rector/Officer In-Charge on Anti-Ragging/Warden/Janitor, Anti-Ragging Squad, Anti-Ragging Committee, Monitoring Committee, district and local administration numbers of Civil, Police and Welfare Departments, emergency response system and other vital information. This type of information besides websites may also be included in the prospectus/ information brochures/ information boards at prominent/ places. This may kindly be communicated to all Regulatory Bodies/Institutions. Media campaign on Anti-Ragging could also be one of the agenda items. UGC was also to have a Master Folder in its website containing all the information of the Regulatory Bodies. We can also discuss action taken on the minutes of last meeting dated 21.3.2014 (A-I). UGC had also to finalize action to include anti-Casteism/Anti-Racism in the definition/ambit of ragging, especially in the light of the unfortunate killing of a North East youth. A copy of the letter written by the then HRM to the Chairman UGC is enclosed (A-III) (this was followed by a good number of reminders). Protection of NE students could also be discussed as a part of anti-ragging measure. Ragging taking place in Medical Institutions could be another item for discussion. Ragging now taking place in new forms could also be one of the discussion points. The Tamil Nadu example quoted by the Bezbaruah Committee (copies enclosed- A-IV) could be another one for discussion.

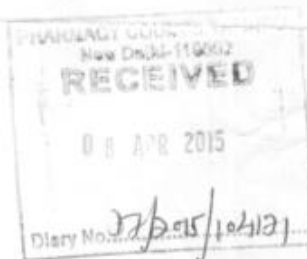

  - (e) All the Deans of Government Medical Colleges were instructed to form Anti-Ragging Committee with the Dean as Chairperson, HODs, Senior Teachers of the institution, and according to UGC regulations, 2009 being laid down for this purpose.
3. It is further submitted that the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University has also set-up state level Anti-Ragging Committee to examine the problems regarding ragging activities in all its affiliated Medical Colleges from the academic year 2012-13.

With reference to letter क्रमांक प. 3(1) शिक्षा-4/2007-पार्ट जयपुर. दिनांक: 27.11.2014 of Dr. Dilip Kumar Goyal, Joint Secretary, Higher Education, Education(Group-4) Department, Govt. of Rajasthan, Jaipur pertaining to captioned subject, we would like to state that our University since its inception has laid an example in ensuring "Zero Tolerance against ragging of any sort".

The University has adopted following measures to curb the menace of ragging these are viz:

- ↓ Constant Interaction between the faculty members & the students.
- ↓ Providing publicity against Anti-ragging matters through notice boards displayed in various faculties & departments, billboards installed at the

conspicuous places of the University premises as well as through the Bi-monthly Newspaper published by Jodhpur National University.

4 Both the students and the parents are to give an Undertaking at the beginning of academic session declaring that they should be severally and jointly liable should their words are found to be involved in ragging activities.

4 University unlike others, do not treat the new students as Freshers. Immediately upon their admission, new students are involved in the social activities along with the senior students. Therefore, the question of new students getting ragged by the old ones does not arise.

4 In both the boys and girls hostels from the day one, New Students are to share rooms with their senior counterparts, hence, a comfort zone that forms to exist, does not help in creating ragging like atmosphere.

4 University premises are also manually kept under strong surveillance by the guards positioned at each wing of the University buildings.

4 With all these measures having been kept active, particularly during first six months of each academic session and the rest of the session in general, the University feels proud to inform your good office that this University is totally immunized from the menace of ragging.

4 And to keep this immunity fortified, the Anti-ragging committee headed by Proctor- Dr Anil Bhandari has been active 24x7 to ensure that all concerned in the premises adhered to zero tolerance against ragging.

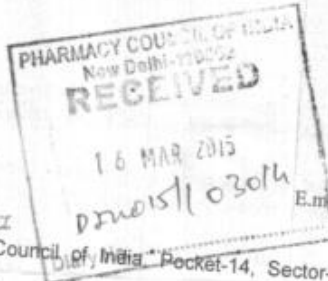

Dear Sir,

I'm writing on behalf of the Society Against Violence in Education (SAVE) - a well known non-profit organization working exclusively for the eradication of ragging.

This communication is in response to a complaint of ragging, that has come to us a few hours ago. The nature of the complaint is seriously shocking which warrants us to write to you.

The complainant states about the victim (1st semester M.B.B.S. student) "being beaten up... sexual assault people are asking to shave their genitals and show the seniors, smoke forcefully people are slapping him more than 10 times just for fun and ext[ortion] verbal abuse".

Clearly such acts involve serious human rights violations and involve criminal offenses, according to the rules.

Though it is easy to dismiss this complaint, we sincerely request you to kindly look into the matter urgently on humanitarian grounds, and to ensure effective protection for the juniors.

Some of the specific recommendations we make to you (in addition) are:

- \* To maintain the surprise raids by the anti-ragging squad,
- \* To install CCTV cameras in the common areas of hostels, canteens, library, etc.
- \* To call the fresher's party as soon as possible, if not yet conducted
- \* To keep drop-boxes at various places in the fresher hostels where freshers can, even anonymously, drop their grievances.
- \* To provide the telephone number of anti-ragging squad to each fresher,
- \* To conduct a survey among freshers to gauge the extent of ragging.
- \* To take affidavit from each senior and his/her parents not to indulge in ragging.
- \* **To keep the freshers in a separate hostel**, and not allow entry of seniors after 9 p.m.
- \* To punish those found guilty with an severe, exemplary punishment

*undertaking in Rajpiper*

Let us also remind that most of the recommendations above are mandatory in nature, to be implemented by the colleges, as required by the UGC REGULATION ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, 2008, and also by the Medical Council of India (Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Medical Colleges/Institutions) Regulations, 2009 - mandatory for all medical colleges in India.

We will also like to share our experience at another institution in MP, where the then newly appointed institute director hired 4 private security guards for nights, gave them two bikes and two mobiles, and gave mobile numbers to every fresher. Entry/ exit of seniors to freshers' hostel was not allowed after 9 p.m. Ragers caught red-handed were severely fined/ punished by the institute. When our NGO visited the college and conducted the survey, it was found that ragging **dropped by more than 90% in just an year in that college.**

**We earnestly expect your kind and urgent action in this regard. A little action can bring the sense of security, safety and self-confidence back in hundreds of lives again!**

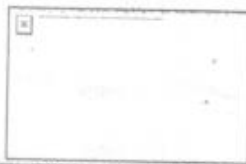
