This is in continuation to Council's repeated instructions to update the student data on Council's website. It has been noted that inspite of repeated pursuance the same is not yet uploaded on Council's website.

In this connection please note that updation of the student data by the pharmacy institutions on Council's website is of utmost importance failing which students admitted may not be registered by the State Pharmacy Councils as the State Pharmacy Councils are being advised by this Council to refer to said student details from Council's website for verification of the data regarding student name, address, qualification, number of admissions approved by the PCI to a particular institution etc. before registering the candidates.
