With reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to inform that subject cited issue was considered by the 281st/Executive Committee of the PCI in its meeting held in Nov, 2017 which -

- Noted that except Education Regulations, 1991 for the Diploma course in Pharmacy and Pharm.D. Regulations, 2008 for Pharm.D course, there were no regulations for other pharmacy courses. Now, the following Regulations are in force duly approved by the Govt. of India and notified in the Gazette of India
 - a) Education Regulations, 1991 for the Diploma course in Pharmacy
 - b) Pharm.D. Regulations, 2008.
 - The Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014.
 - The Master of Pharmacy (M.Pharm) Course Regulations, 2014.
 - Bachelor of Pharmacy (Practice) Regulations, 2014.
 - Minimum Qualification for Teachers in Pharmacy Institutions Regulations, 2014.
 - Pharmacy Practice Regulations, 2015.

These regulations are available on Council's website.

- In view of the provisions contained in the statutory regulations, it was decided to issue circular to all pharmacy institutions clarifying that hitherto
 - all approvals granted by the PCI u/s 12 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 will only be from a prospective date.

b) no admission shall be made by the institution in any pharmacy course without prior a approval of the PCI failing which such admission will not be eligible for registration as a pharmacist to practice under the Pharmacy Act.

This is for compliance.
