Dear Archna,

The Committee for the Control and Supervision of Experiments on Animal (CPCSEA) was set up by the Govt. of India on 8th February, 1991 in pursuance of Section 15(1) of Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960. The objective of CPCSEA is to ensure that animals are not subjected to unnecessary pains or suffering before, during or after experiments on them. The Central Government constituted the Committee which is duty bound to take all such measures as may be necessary to ensure that animals are not subject to unnecessary pain or suffering before, during or after performance of experiments on them.

- The aim of the Committee is to ensure humane and ethical use of animals, while facilitating legitimate scientific research involving experiments on animals. For this purpose, the Committee has formulated the "Breeding of and Experiments on Animals (Control & Supervision) Rules, 1998" (amended in 2001 & 2006) to regulate the experimentation on animals. Under the provisions of the above Rules, establishments who are engaged in Bio-Medical Research and conducting experimentation on animals are required to get themselves registered with CPCSEA, constitute Institutional Animal Ethics Committees (IAEC), get their Animal House Facilities inspected, and also get specific projects for research cleared by IAEC/CPCSEA before commencing the research on animals. Further, breeding and trade of animals for such experimentation are also regulated under these Rules. Till date 1590 establishments are registered with CPCSEA.
  - I am writing to you in reference to MoEF&CC's letter of even number dated 10th February, 2011, 29th May, 2014 and 1st July, 2015 (Copies enclosed) wherein, PCI \$ 42 was requested to direct all the establishments/ colleges/ institutions under them, to register with the CPCSEA also.

I would like to bring into your kind notice that, inspite of continuous efforts of CPCSEA and PCI, there are still some unregistered establishments conducting animal research and non-complaint with the Guidelines of CPCSEA. You may be aware that the website of CPCSEA (http://cpcsea.nic.in) has already been launched and the applications for registration are accepted 'online'. The procedure for applying online and the requisite

documents for registration are enclosed.

Use of Animals by establishments under the Medical Council of India (MCI) -Fax No. 011-23239184. Subject:-Guidelines regarding.

The Committee for the Purpose of Control and Supervision of Experiments on Animals (CPCSEA) has been constituted under the provisions of Section 15 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960. The CPCSEA functions within the ambit of the Act and the Sir, Rules for Breeding of and Experiments on Animals (Control & Supervision), 1998 as named the aim of the CPCSEA is to ensure humane and ethical use of animals, while facilitating legitimate scientific research involving experiments on animals. As per the extant rules it is mandatory that every establishment involved in breeding and experimentation should get registered with CPCSEA.

I quote below, for your ready reference, the relevant sections of the aforesaid Rules:

Rule 3: (a) No establishment shall carry on the business of breeding of animals or trade of

(b) Every breeder / establishment carrying on the business of breeding animals or animals for the purpose of experiments unless it is registered. trade of animals for the purpose of experiments, shall, apply for registration within sixty days from the date of commencement of these rules and, stop breeding of animals if registration is subsequently refused to it by the Committee.

No establishment shall perform any experiments on animals unless it is Rule 4: (a)

Every establishment performing experiments on animals, shall, apply for

registration within sixty days from the date of commencement of these rules and stop registered. performing experiments on animals.

Rule 14 empowers CPCSEA to direct closure of the animal house facility if the rules made by it are not complied with by the establishment or breeder.

- I am also directed to inform you that S. 19 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, empowers the CPCSEA to prohibit any person / institution from carrying on any experiments if it is satisfied that the rules made by it are not being adhered to. If the contravention of any directions or breach of conditions issued by the CPCSEA u/s 19 has taken place in any institution / establishment, then the person in charge of the institution / establishment shall be deemed to be guilty of the offence and punishable as per Section 20 of Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act.
- In addition to the above, you are also advised that persons / institutions guilty of the breach of these mandatory requirements, and functioning without the supervision or regulation envisaged by these Rules, shall additionally render themselves liable under the applicable provisions of the Indian Penal Code, including but not limited to Section 428 and 429 of the said enactment.
- In view of the above, kindly direct the establishments / colleges / institutions units registered with the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), to register them with the CPCSEA, so that inspection of the establishments carrying out experiments on animals can be conducted, and they can be subject to the supervision and regulation that the law of the land deems

Kindly keep us informed of the steps you take in this regard.

# Procedure for applying online

- Step-I: It is required to 'sign up' in the User Login Window available at the Home Page.
- Step-II: The user is required to login through User Login Window at Home Page by selecting 'Establishment Login' in User type and put their User Name & Password, which were entered during sign-up Form.

# Following requisite documents are required to be submitted during online application:

- Application as per revised Form 'A' for registration. (Each column of Form A is to be filled online).
- ii. The Blueprint / Layout plan of the Animal House Facility of the establishment, having the details of the various rooms with measurements for keeping animals, feed storage, wash room, office room etc as per CPCSEA guidelines, duly signed by the Head of the establishment and the Architect.
- Minutes of the internal IAEC meeting, wherein recommendation for CPCSEA registration has been approved by the IAEC.
- iv. Approval letter from the Government/ Autonomous Council (viz. AICTE/PCI/MCI) or Company Registration Certificate.
- v. The biodata and consent letters of 5 internal IAEC members (Biodata format available on the website).
- vi. The Establishment is required to deposit the registration fee through 'online payment gateway' in the prescribed column at the time of the submission of online form for registration.
