Please refer to D.O. letter No. F.2-5/2010/Stat. dated the 27th May, 2011, form Dr. Vijay P. Goel, Deputy Director General, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Government of India, requesting you to advise the institutions under your control to extend cooperation in the work relating to the All India Survey of Higher Education (copy enclosed for ready reference - Annexure I). As already intimated, National University of Educational Planning and Administration (NUEPA) has been given the responsibility for conducting the survey work. Ms. P. Bolina has been appointed as the Project Director for All India Survey of Higher Education in NUEPA. A list of other officers associated with the survey work is at Annexure - II.

- For the purpose of the survey, higher education has been defined as education which is obtained after completing 12 years of schooling or equivalent and is of a duration of at least 9 months (full time) or after completing 10 years of schooling and is of a duration of at least 3 years. The education may be of the nature of General, Vocational, Professional or Technical Education. The survey envisages to identify and capture all institutions of higher learning in the country. The data thus generated would be extremely useful for policy formulation, research, fulfilling international commitments etc.
- A Portal has been developed by NIC (URL:http://aishe.gov.in) on which all the survey related 3. information is available. While Universities are required to fill up the complete data in DCF I and Colleges affiliated to them in DCF II, the Data Capture Format - III (DCF-III) has been prepared for stand alone institutions not affiliated to any university but which are recognized by some Council/ Central Government/ State Governments etc.
- 4. A State Coordinating Agency (SCA) is being nominated in each State for coordinating the survey work in respect of Affiliating Universities/ Non - affiliating Universities/ Colleges/ Institutions. They will be organizing training workshops for orientation of the representatives of the Universities/ Colleges/ Institutions etc.
- 5. I solicit your cooperation in this important mission and request you once again to advise the institutions under your control to extend cooperation in the work of the All India Survey of Higher Education. With collective efforts in completing the survey work at the earliest, we are hopeful of putting together vast information on higher education in the country. This will create a new and reliable data base which will provide authenticated and formation on the status of blades education in India. New Dalhi- 10 002

Ministry of Human Resource Development is conducting an All India Survey on Higher Education to prepare a sound database on higher education. Data will be collected from all the Institutions of Higher Learning located in the Country. A Task Force has been constituted under the chairmanship of Shri Sunil Kumar, Additional Secretary (Higher Education), MHRD to oversee the whole survey work. National University of Education Planning & Administration (NUEPA), New Delhi has been given the responsibility of conducting the survey. Main Survey is proposed to be conducted during June-July, 2011.

In this regard a meeting was convened by Secretary, Higher Education on 18.05.2011 with chairpersons of University Grants Commission, All India Council for Technical Education, Indian Nursing Council and National Council for Teacher Education wherein it was decided that all the regulatory bodies may upload the survey related documents on their websites and issue instruction to the institution under their control for cooperation and to provide necessary information. It was also decided in the meeting that all statutory regulators would publicise the survey and make it obligatory for the standalone institutions coming within their purview to furnish information to investigators.
