
The Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) with the approval of the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India has notified the “Diploma in Pharmacy Exit Examination Regulations, 2022” in Extraordinary Gazette of India, No.109, Part III - Section 4, dated 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2022.

In this connection, it is clarified that the PCI is in the process of finalizing the modalities for implementation of the “Diploma in Pharmacy Exit Examination Regulations, 2022” as per the said notification.

Till then the State Pharmacy Councils are requested to continue to register the passed out students as per the procedure already in vogue subject to compliance of conditions prescribed u/s 32(2) of the Pharmacy Act, 1948.
