
With reference to the subject cited above, it is informed that the subject cited issue was considered by 356<sup>th</sup> Executive Committee of the PCI in its meeting held on 3.12.2021 which decided that the PCI has not approved Higher Secondary Examination (Vocational) of Council of Higher Secondary Education (CHSE), Odisha under following Regulations for admission to following pharmacy courses -

Name of the Course	Name of Regulations
D.Pharm	Regulation 4. of the Educations Regulations, 2020 for the Diploma Course in Pharmacy.
B.Pharm	Regulation 4.A.ii of the Bachelor of Pharmacy (B.Pharm.) Course Regulations, 2014.
Pharm. D	Regulation 4.(3) of the Pharm. D. Regulations, 2008.

In view of above, students holding Higher Secondary Examination (Vocational) of CHSE, Odisha, should not be admitted to D.Pharm, B.Pharm and Pharm.D courses failing which the students will not be eligible for registration as a pharmacist under the Pharmacy Act, 1948 and the entire consequences for the same shall rest on the Odisha State Government and PCI will not be responsible for it.
