Sub: Comments of the State Governments /Union Territories on the proposed amendment in regulation 4 of the "The Education Regulations, 2020 for Diploma Course in Pharmacy" (ER-20).

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject cited above, it is informed that -

- The Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) is a statutory body working under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, New Delhi. It is constituted under the Pharmacy Act, 1948 to regulate the profession and practice of pharmacy in the country.
- With due approval of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India, the PCI has notified the Education Regulations, 2020 for Diploma course in Pharmacy in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary No. 435, Part III, Section- 4, dt. 16.10.2020. These Regulations are available on the Council's website www.pci.nic.in
- 3. The 111th Central Council of the PCI in its meeting held in April, 2020 decided that in order to bring quality assurance in pharmacy education, there should be age restrictions for admission to pharmacy courses. In view of it, please find enclosed herewith the proposed amendment in regulation 4 of the Education Regulations, 2020 for Diploma course in Pharmacy as Appendix-1.

The Council would, appreciate to have considered comments of the State Governments / Union Territories on the enclosed proposed amendment within 3 months of issuance of this letter as required under sub-section (3) of section 10 of the Pharmacy Act, 1948 to enable the Pharmacy Council of India to take further action in the matter.

### The proposed amendment in regulation 4 of the Education Regulations, 2020 for Diploma Course in Pharmacy

#### **Principal Regulation**

## **Proposed Amendment**

 Diploma in Pharmacy (Part-I and Part-II) - Minimum qualification for admission to Diploma in Pharmacy-A pass in 10+2 examination (science academic stream) with Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Mathematics.

or

Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to the above examination.

Provided that there shall be reservation of seats for the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes candidates in accordance with the instructions issued by the Central Government /State Governments /Union territory administrations as the case may be from time to time.

 Diploma in Pharmacy (Part-I and Part-II) - Minimum qualification for admission to Diploma in Pharmacy-A pass in 10+2 examination (science academic stream) with Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Mathematics.

or

Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to the above examination.

Provided that the candidate has passed 10+2 (science academic stream) in the last 5 years at the time of taking admission to Diploma in Pharmacy Course.

Provided that there shall be reservation of seats for the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes candidates in accordance with the instructions issued by the Central Government /State Governments /Union territory administrations as the case may be from time to time.
