The said circular stands withdrawn.

- In this connection, it is intimated that
 - the PCI portal for online submission of application in SIF by existing institutions was opened from 14.12.2021 to 5.1.2022.
 - b) the existing institutions which could not apply during the said period are hereby given a last opportunity to apply online on PCI portal between 28.3.2022 to 1.4.2022 with penalty of Rs.1 lakh along with GST on the same.
 - c) the existing institutions may apply for -
 - Continuation of approval
 - ii) Introduction of new course
 - iii) Raise in admission
 - iv) Services
 - d) the other conditions for existing institutions with regard to Pharmacy Education Regulatory Charges, GST, submission of statutory documents for introduction of new pharmacy course(s) / raise in admission / services etc. will remain same as mentioned in Council's earlier circular No.14-56/2021-PCI (Approval Process for 2022-2023 a.s.) / 5669-71 dt.9.12.2021. The said circular dt.9.12.2021 is available on Council's website.
- 3. Please note that this is the last opportunity to the existing institutions and no further extension of date will be done by the Council.
