23.1 The latest information on record including findings of Personal Hearing Committee (PHC) dt.29.9.2020 was placed and considered.

23.2 It was noted that -

- a) out of claimed 10 teaching faculty, only 4 faculty were present in PHC and the Principal was not able to justify the absence of other claimed faculty members.
- b) Shri Mahesh Sangepaga shown as faculty of Pharmaceutics was not able to tell the name of his colleagues working in the institution.
- c) Institution in its mail dt.25.9.2020 enclosed a copy of letter dt.24.9.2020 signed by the Principal. In the said communication qualification of Dr. Konda Shraavan Kumar, Principal and Professor was reflected as M.Pharm (Pharmaceutics) whereas in the earlier appeal dt.15.5.2020, his qualification was reflected as M.Pharm (Pharmaceutical Biotechnology). Same was observed in case of other teaching staff also. The Principal was not able to explain the reason for this anomaly and stated that he had signed two blank letter heads of the institution and given to institution for use as he was in quarantine due to COVID-19. He said that computer operator has sent the information.

23.3 Considering the above, it was decided as under -

- i) Whenever feasible after COVID-19 pandemic, another PHC be held in person where teaching staff in person shall appear before PHC alongwith Principal.
- ii) Till then the earlier decision of the Council be reiterated with regard to M.Pharm course.

23.4 It was further decided to share the findings of PHC with the Principal and seek clarification as to why action under regulation (ix) of “Minimum Qualification for Teachers in Pharmacy Institutions Regulations, 2014” should not be initiated against it for providing false information to PCI.
